Only original artwork will be considered. No kits, imports, resale or manufactured items will be accepted.

I understand that tents are welcome and electricity is not available. Early breakdown is not permitted and I will be present during all Festival hours. The fee to participate in the 9th Annual Narrows Festival of the Arts is \$35.
